Post-bloom only - typically 2-3 weeks after bloom

### **Application Tips**

- Rainfast when dry
- After Envidor is applied, mites never emerge to next stage. Early life stages develop the fastest, therefore early applications result in faster control
- Re-entry period 12 hours
- Do not make more than one application of Envidor per year
- Pre-harvest interval 7 days in treefruit, 14 days in grapes
