#### Application Tips

Carefully follow use directions for this seed flow lubricant.

#### Application Tips

- Use 1/8 cup per seed unit - DO NOT OVER APPLY!
  - For sweet corn, up to 1/4 cup can be used
- Always stir or mix the product into the seed. Make sure the Fluency Agent is dispersed and not clumped together. Mixing should not take more than 30 seconds
- Centre fill planters
  - Add Fluency Agent to the tote before filling the planter box
